SCOUTING THE LONESTARS

Like most teams in the Texas Collegiate League the Mineral Wells Steam and the Eules Lonestars are feeling the effects of the NCAA baseball playoffs. For the Lonestars, however, it has meant practicing and playing the first weeks of the season without head coach Rob Penders who is wrapping his duties up with the University of Texas. Assistant skipper Alan McDougal, the head coach at Sherman (Tex.) HS, will be at the helm when the Lonestars host the Steam on Tuesday night. Left-handed pitcher Johnny Noland gets the opening day nod. Noland was 1-3 with a 5.02 ERA in 15 appearances for Centenary College in the spring. Noland struck out 25 batters in 43 innings and started six games for the Gents. Noland pitched for the Lonestars in 2005, going 0-3 with a 6.30 ERA in five games.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Steam play two road games and get a day off before hosting the Duncanville Deputies for the home opener at Pratt Field on Friday at 7:05. After the trip to Eules, the Steam travel west to Graham and play the Roughnecks on Wednesday. The Steam open the 2006 home schedule against expansion-franchise Duncanville on Friday. Friday is Mineral Wells Area Chamber of Commerce Night and there will be a post-game fireworks show.

AROUND THE HORN

Ben Burum (UTA), Brock Wilson (UTA) and Steven Trout (TCU) reported to Mineral Wells on Monday and took part in their first practice. Twenty-one of the Steam's 24 players have reported and will be available for tonight's contest. Burum and Tyson Bagley (Cisco JC) are the lone returners for the Steam. Tyler Rowland (DBU), tonight's starter, was with the Steam during the 2004 season, but didn't play due to injury. Rowland was 1-0 with an 8.57 ERA in 14 games and three starts for the Patriots this season. Dallas Cowboy legend and 2006 Pro Football Hall of Fame inductee Rayfield Wright will throw out the first pitch in celebration of tonight's TCL and home opener in Eules.

STEAM HEAD COACH MIKE BARD



Mike Bard is currently full-time staff with Athletes in Action Baseball. He came on staff after 15 years of Division I College coaching experience. Most recently he was the head coach at Dallas Baptist University from 2002-2004, where he was NCCAA National Coach of the Year both years. He led the Patriots to a 44-16 season during their first year of Division I play in 2004.

Prior to his one-year stint at UTA for the 2001-2002 season, Bard was a member of the University of Kansas coaching staff from 1996-2001. He served as the recruiting coordinator and primary outfield and catching coach for the Jayhawks, as well as a hitting instructor. The Jayhawks set the school record with a .327 team batting average in 1997 and broke that mark the next year with a .328 team average.

Bard started his coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Texas Tech University, where he served as a graduate/volunteer assistant from 1991-1995. In 1995, Texas Tech led the nation in hitting with a .344 team batting average. Bard served as the head coach for Athletes in Action in the summer of 1993 on a team that toured Alaska, China, the Philippines, and Canada. Bard holds a Master's of Education degree and a Bachelor's of Science in Exercise and Sports Sciences from Texas Tech University. He and his wife, Alisa, have four children.
